**PERMIT CONDITIONS:**

1. Pursuant to California Fish and Game Code Section 395 and Section 670, Title 14, of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) you must have a valid falconry license in your immediate possession at all time while capturing or attempting to capture raptors in California.
2. Pursuant to Section 670(c)(4)(C), Title 14, of the CCR, only the following raptors may be taken from the wild: Northern goshawk (*Accipiter gentilis*) (see subsection (c)(4)(D) for restrictions), Cooper's hawk (*Accipiter cooperii*), sharp-shinned hawk (*Accipiter striatus*), red-tailed hawk (*Buteo jamaicensis*), ferruginous hawk (*Buteo regalis*), merlin (*Falco columbarius*), American kestrel (*Falco sparverius*), prairie falcon (*Falco mexicanus*) and great horned owl (*Bubo virginianus*).
3. Pursuant to Section 670(c)(4)(B), Title 14, of the CCR, upon capture of a raptor you must notify the California department of Fish and wildlife (Department) by filling out the bottom portion of this permit and returning this entire form within five days to the Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, 1740 N. Market Blvd., Sacramento, California 95834. A copy of a current 7.5 minute U.S. Geological Survey topographic map, with the capture site clearly indicated, shall be mailed to the Department at the address indicated above within 14 days of take. The map location-reporting requirement\* is for all species listed above, except red-tailed hawk, American kestrel, and great horned owl.
4. When recording coordinates of the capture site, please use UTM (Universal Transverse Mercator) Projection, including Zone, Easting and Northing. Example of UTM in written format: UTM Zone 10; 644886E, 4301511N. Map coordinates (Latitude/Longitude) can be converted to UTM coordinates by using online conversion tools such as GEOTRANS (Geographic Translator). If a GPS unit is not used in the field, UTM's can be obtained by using online tools such as Google Earth.
5. If unsuccessful, this permit must be completed and returned to the address listed above within five days of the expiration of this permit.
6. You are not authorized to trespass upon private property or restricted areas on state and federally owned property.
