Under the Oil Pollution Act of 1990, the Natural Resource Trustees prepared the DARP/EA to assess injuries and evaluate restoration alternatives for natural resources injured by the Cosco Busan Oil Spill.

This is to advise that the Department of Fish and Game, Office of Spill Prevention and Response has approved the above-described project on April 9, 2012 and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment
