Short Proposal Title: Fish Treadmill

1. Applicability to CALFED ERP Goals and Implementation Plan and CVPIA priorities, and relevance to ERP and CVPIA priorities for your region. CALFED Goal 1 (at-risk species) and Goal 3(recreational fisheries) and several Stage 1 actions. Per CVPIA staff review, all species listed would benefit, but there is no direct link to AFRP goals or CVPIA priorities.
