Panel agrees with TARP that there is no evidence of an effect on the Central Valley. There are at least three reservoirs between source of sediment in the upper Trinity watershed and the Sacramento River system that will likely trap all sediments before they reach the river.

- 3. Feasibility, especially the project's ability to move forward in a timely and successful manner.** Need support from primary landowners to be feasible. Action plan needs to be further developed.
