<b>Hunting Licenses</b> - Required to take any bird or mammal.	
<b>Junior</b> (Resident/Nonresident under 16 years of age) .....	\$11.62
<b>Resident</b> .....	44.85
<b>Nonresident</b> .....	155.52
<b>Disabled Veteran Hunting License</b> .....	7.05
<b>Two-Day Nonresident</b> (Non Game, Small Game & Game Birds Only) .....	44.85
<b>Duplicate Hunting License</b> (Annual license only) .....	9.98
<b>Deer Tags</b> - Residents and nonresidents <b>must be at least 12 years of age at the time of transaction.</b>	
<b>Resident First-Deer Tag</b> .....	\$29.98
<b>Nonresident First-Deer Tag</b> .....	263.01
<b>Resident Second-Deer Tag</b> .....	36.98
<b>Nonresident Second-Deer Tag</b> .....	263.01
<b>Bear Tag</b> - Residents and nonresidents <b>must be at least 12 years of age at the time of transaction.</b>	
<b>Resident Bear Tag</b> .....	\$43.46
<b>Nonresident Bear Tag</b> .....	277.10
<b>Wild Pig Tags</b> - Residents and nonresidents <b>must be at least 12 years of age at the time of transaction.</b> May purchase multiple pig tags.	
<b>Resident Wild Pig Tag</b> .....	\$21.34
<b>Nonresident Wild Pig Tag</b> .....	71.54
<b>Bobcat Tags</b> - A hunter may purchase up to five bobcat tags per license year.....	\$3.19
<b>Upland Game Bird Validation</b> - Required for any person taking upland game bird species, <b>except</b> those hunting under the authority of a junior hunting license .....	\$9.21
<b>California Duck Validation</b> - Required for any person taking ducks, geese, or brant, <b>except</b> those hunting under the authority of a junior hunting license .....	\$19.44
<b>Duplicate Validations</b> - (Upland Game Bird and California Duck) .....	\$3.24
<b>Duplicate Hunter Education Certificate</b> .....	\$5.97
<b>Harvest Information Program (HIP) Validation</b> - Required for any person taking migratory game birds (duck, dove, band-tailed pigeon, brant, coots, gallinules, geese, and snipe) .....	NO FEE
<b>Reservation Drawing Applications for State-Operated Hunting Areas</b> - Allows a licensed hunter to apply for a reservation drawing to hunt on a state-operated Wildlife Area (per choice).....	\$1.34
<b>Hunting Area Passes</b> - Required for any person to hunt during legal waterfowl and pheasant hunting season on authorized hunt days, <b>except</b> those hunting under the authority of a junior hunting license. Allows bearer(s) access to State-operated Wildlife Areas if space is available, without further payment of any daily hunting fee.	
<b>Type A One-Day Pass</b> - Allows hunting Access for one day to Type A State-operated Wildlife Areas.....	\$20.01
<b>Type A Two-Day Pass</b> - May be used by one person for any two authorized shoot days; or by two persons on any one authorized shoot day for any type A State-operated Wildlife Area .....	\$32.40
<b>Type A Season Pass</b> - Unlimited season access to Type A and Type B State-operated Wildlife Areas .....	\$150.69
<b>Type B Season Pass</b> - Unlimited Season Access to Type B State-operated Wildlife Areas.....	\$50.25
<b>Non-Hunting Area Passes</b> - Required for non-hunting users without a fishing or hunting license at Lake Earl, Ash Creek, Gray Lodge, Grizzly Island, Los Banos, San Jacinto, Imperial (Wister Unit) Wildlife Areas and Elkhorn Slough Ecological Reserve.	
<b>Daily DFG Lands Pass</b> .....	\$4.32
<b>Annual DFG Lands Pass</b> .....	23.25
