#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Mobility Impaired hunters may bring two non-hunting guests if additional assistance is required. Enclosed you will find a map to the hunt check station. A specific hunt area will be assigned to you when you check in. All hunters must show valid hunting licenses with upland game bird stamp (if an adult) and Mobility Impaired hunters must have proof of disability (DMV placard). Check in will begin one hour before shoot time (30 minutes before sunrise.) So as not to disturb hunters that are already hunting, <a href="mailto:entry on to the hunting area will not be permitted more than one hour after shoot time begins!">entry on to the hunting area will not be permitted more than one hour after shoot time begins!</a>!

Please note that each member of your party must hunt together in the assigned area. Hunting partners that separate will lose their privileges to hunt. Scouting prior to the hunt is not allowed as this property is not open to the public other than for the hunt day. If you see unauthorized hunters please let the check station operator know immediately so that law enforcement officers can respond. If this hunt is successful this year, the Preserve will consider continuing and/or expanding this opportunity in future years.



## The Ten Commandments of Firearms Safety:

- 1. Watch that muzzle! Keep it pointed in a safe direction at all times.
  - 2. Treat every firearm with the respect due a loaded gun.
- 3. Be sure of your target and what is in front of it and beyond it.
- 4. Keep your finger outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot .
  - 5. Check your barrel and ammunition.
  - 6. Unload firearms when not in use.
  - 7. Point your firearm only at something you intend to shoot.
    - 8. Don't run, jump, or climb with a loaded firearm.
    - 9. Store firearms and ammunition separately and safely.
- 10. Don't drink alcohol, use drugs or take medications that might impair your abilities and good judgment before or while handling firearms or archery equipment.
