



California Klamath Management Zone June 2013 Commercial Salmon Fishery Information

ATTENTION: Commercial Salmon Trollers and Dealers

The commercial salmon fishery in the California KMZ (Oregon/California border to Humboldt South Jetty) will open on Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at 12:01am and close at 11:59pm.* All salmon must be landed within 24 hours of the closure.

*Total landings will be evaluated on Wednesday, June 12 and the fishery may re-open if final tally of landings falls below quota.

AREA OPEN: Oregon/California Border to Humboldt South Jetty

- **June 1-9, 11 or 3,352** Chinook salmon quota
- Landing and possession limit of 20 Chinook per vessel per day
- All salmon caught must be landed within the area and within 24 hours of the fishery closure

Fishery Requirements:

- Minimum size limit: 27 inches total length
- Klamath Control Zone closed (12 mile square centered on Klamath River mouth)
- All salmon except coho
- Single-point, single-shank barbless hooks are required
- No more than 6 lines are allowed per vessel
- All salmon must be made available to Department staff for sampling – Cal. Fish & Game Code §7702.
- All salmon landed must be documented with a Department landing receipt and submitted to the Department as required by Cal. Fish & Game Code §8043-8047.
- Vessels fishing south of Horse Mountain may not land fish in the KMZ
