- 3. **IMPORTANT:** If you do not own the property where your falconry facilities are located, you must submit with this application a signed and dated statement from the property owner stating that he/she agrees that the falconry facilities, equipment and raptors may be inspected without advance notice, as specified in Section 670(j).
- 4. Mail this application, your GO ID# or a copy of your identification, a Falconry Hunting Take Report, a statement from the property owner if required and a cashier's check, money order, personal or business check\*, or credit card\*\* authorization form (online at www.dfg.ca.gov/licensing/forms (under the Other Forms tab) with the appropriate fee to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, 1740 N. Market Blvd., Sacramento, CA 95834 or apply in person. **DO NOT SEND CASH**.
- 5. An apprentice must also submit an Apprentice Falconer's Annual Progress Report with their application, which is available online at www.dfg.ca.gov/licensing/forms (under the Special Permits tab).
- 6. If you move your permanent falconry facility to another location, as specified in Section 670(j), you are required to notify the Department within five days and submit a completed Raptor Facilities and Falconry Equipment Inspection Report (FG 360d) and the inspection fee, as specified in Section 703. The Department will contact you about scheduling an appointment to have your facility inspected.

A person applying for a California falconry license for the first time or renewing a license that has lapsed for five or more years must take and pass a written examination given at any California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) office listed below and have their facility inspected by the Department. An applicant who provides documentation of successfully passing a federally approved examination in a state that has had its falconry regulations certified as specified in Title 50, CFR, Section 21.29, will not be required to take the examination in California if the applicant took the exam within five years from the date the application was submitted. Applicants must be 12 years of age or older to be issued an apprentice license and may possess only a red-tailed hawk or an American kestrel. Applicants under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian co-sign this application.

- **1. Who Can Apply?** An applicant may be a resident or a nonresident and possess a valid General or Master falconry license at the time of application to enter the drawing. A resident applicant shall not submit more than two drawing each regulatory year. A nonresident applicant shall not submit more than one drawing application each regulatory year.
- 2. Get Outdoors Identification Number (GO ID). Every person who is issued a license through ALDS is issued a permanent identification number. Your GO ID is printed on every license item. It is used to retrieve your customer information each time you purchase a license, apply for drawings, and to look up drawing results. If you have previously purchased any ALDS license, make sure you provide your GO ID when applying for this drawing to retrieve your customer information.

If you are a Nonresident, who has never previously purchased any ALDS license and would like to apply online instead of submitting this application by mail, you must submit either by e-mail spu@wildlife.ca.gov or fax (916) 419-7586 a copy of your valid falconry license and identification.

- **3. Identification Required.** ALDS regulations require you to present identification at the time of application. This also ensures that the Department will have an accurate record of our license customers in an electronic database. Acceptable proof of identification:
  - Any license document or Get Outdoors identification number (GO ID) previously issued via ALDS
  - A valid driver's license or identification card issued to him or her by the Department of Motor Vehicles or by the entity issuing driver's licenses from the licensee's state of domicile

- US Certificate or Report of Birth Abroad
- US Birth Certificate
- Tribal Identification Card, as defined by each sovereign tribal nation
- US Passport

- Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship
- Birth Certificate or passport issued from a US Territory

Applicants who are less than 18 years of age may provide any form of identification described above or a guardian's identification (parent or legal guardian identification listed above). Upon receipt of the notification, the successful applicant shall submit the Raptor Capture Permit Fee, as specified in Section 703, to the Department's License and Revenue Branch by 5:00 p.m. on June 1, 2014 to claim the permit. If the deadline to submit the fee falls on a weekend or holiday, payment will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on the first state business day following the deadline to submit payment. Unclaimed permits shall be awarded to alternates for that species and/or area after June 1, 2014 on an individual basis, in the order drawn

The Raptor Capture Permit shall only be issued to successful applicants that hold a General or Master falconry license that is valid for the same license year that the permit will be valid. Only the permit holder is entitled to capture a raptor, and must be in immediate possession of the permit during the capture. Permits are not transferable and are valid only for the species, area and period as specified on the permit.

## **PAYMENT POLICY**

\*Personal or business checks will be accepted by the Department if name and address are imprinted on the check. Please allow 15 business days for processing. Incomplete applications will be returned and could delay the issuance of your permit. Contact the License and Revenue Branch at (916) 928-5849 or spu@wildlife.ca.gov if you need additional information regarding non-resident falconer raptor capture permits.

- 1. It is mandatory to complete all items.
- Sign and date the application.
- 3. Mail this application and a copy of your state falconry license, a copy of your identification and a cashier's check, money order, personal check\* or credit card\*\* authorization form for the appropriate fee to the Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, 1740 N. Market Blvd., Sacramento, CA 95834 or apply in person. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**

#### INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENT -

Section 700.4(c), Title 14, of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) states any applicant applying for any license, tag, permit, reservation or other entitlement issued via Automated License Data System (ALDS) shall provide valid identification. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Any license document or Get Outdoors identification number (GO ID) previously issued via ALDS
- A valid driver's license or identification card issued to him or her by the Department of Motor Vehicles or by the entity issuing driver's licenses from the licensee's state of domicile
- US Military Identification Cards (Active or reserve duty, dependent, retired member, discharged from service, medical/religious personnel)
- US Certificate or Report of Birth Abroad
- US Birth Certificate
- Tribal Identification Card, as defined by each sovereign tribal nation
- US Passport
- A foreign government-issued photo identification
- Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship
- Birth Certificate or passport issued from a US Territory

Any applicant less than 18 years of age applying for any license, tag, permit, reservation or other entitlement issued via the ALDS shall provide valid identification. Acceptable forms of identification include any form of identification described above; or a parent or legal guardian's identification as described above.

### PAYMENT POLICY -

\*Personal Checks will be accepted by the Department if name and address are imprinted on the check. Personal checks returned to the Department due to insufficient funds will render your permit invalid. The Department may also deny the issuance or renewal of any permit if a person has failed to reimburse the Department for the amount due. Any activity performed without a valid permit is a violation of the Fish and Game Code and therefore subject to enforcement action.

\*\*Credit Cards—Licenses, permits, tags, stamps, or registrations may be purchased with a Visa or MasterCard.
