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Sirs:

We have a cabin in the Tahoe area and I have fished many of the lakes in the Desolation area. Recently a friend of mine has sent me in search of Golden's and I have contacted you in the past and received the excellent booklet by Fisk.

I recently hiked to Saucer Lake for the first time which I understand is stocked with Golden's since 1968. I supposedly received Brookies before then. I found a number of stunted Brookies there but no Golden's (Fish were 8-10" with large heads and thin bodies). I assume they are reproducing naturally in Saucer. This also occurs with better results for the Brookies in Phipps Lake where I have found Brookies in a ratio of at least 10/1, i.e. I've only seen one Golden in several year's fishing.

There are a couple lakes that I am targeting for the Fall: Kalima, Tallac, Cup and Lost (near Pyramid). Of these the only one I believe has gotten Brookies in the past is Lost. Can you advise if the others have ever gotten Brookies and when the last stockings of Golden's were? I will be happy to provide any fishing reports (in each lake I try bait, spinners and flies).
