Subject: Showers Lake, El Dorado County

A 125-foot "spider" gill net and a 125-foot floating gill net were set on September 12, 1967 and pulled on September 13, 1967 after 18 hours of fishing. The water temperature was 60°F. The "spider" net caught 11EB, 25LRS, 5 DA, and 4 EB fingerlings. The floating net caught 4 EB. The EB ranged from 11-13 inches and were excellent condition. They weighed approximately 3/4 lb. to 1 lb. each.

The dam was in good condition and spilling.
