


20. The permittee agrees to take all reasonable precautions to avoid damage to timber, young growth, and watershed cover and diligently to undertake suppressive action in the event of fire resulting from the exercise of the privileges granted herein.


21. Where improvements constructed under this permit require water, the U.S. Forest Service agrees to secure and hold the water rights to the extent possible under the laws of the State of California.


22. Permittee shall remove any trees killed by raise in water level within two years following completion of the dam. The vicinity of the dam shall be cleaned up of all excavation and debris within one year from completion of the dam. ~~Native trees~~ and shrubs shall be planted to conceal the dam as required by the Forest Supervisor. *cut*

23. The permittee has read the foregoing permit and agrees to accept and abide by its terms and conditions.

ELDORADO NATIONAL FOREST

 GUERDON ELLIS, Forest Supervisor

Project Purpose: To provide stream flow in 0.75 miles of outlet stream and to the headwaters of the Upper Truckee River. The outlet stream contains a resident population of rainbow and Eastern brook trout. Before construction of the dam the outlet stream dried up in dry years.

Operation: Recommended release slightly less than 0.25 c.f.s. from time dam stops spilling (usually Aug. 15 through Oct. 15). Flush valve on first visit to lake (usually Aug. 15) and set valve at recommended flow if lake has stopped spilling. Normally the dam is checked again the first part of September and again in early October.

The warden headquartered at Markleeville currently (1963) operates dam.

Remarks:
