The subject water permit was issued to F. K. and R. H. Ausfahl, and C. F. Tuttle, of Richmond, California for 1.2 c.f.s. from Strawberry Creek in Section 19, T11N, R17E, M.D.M. for power purposes. The diversion dam has since been constructed but water has not been diverted.

We would like to know if a protest was ever filed against subject water application, or if there was a provision in the permit that required the permittee to release a stated amount of water to maintain fish life below the dam.

We would also like to know if an application for a water permit for power purposes has been filed by Otto F. Link, W. E. Seavy, and Henry J. Gelling, of Sacramento, California, representing Sacramento Pyramid No. 3, A.E.O. Scouts, or if a permit has been issued to them. The diversion is to be located on Strawberry Creek, El Dorado County, in Sec. 19, T11N, R17E, M.D.M.

In reply to your inquiry of October 18, please be advised that no protests were filed against the approval of Application 10959 which now stands in the name of C. F. Tuttle, R. H. Ausfahl and Rowena E. Ausfahl. Permit 6476 issued pursuant to this application contains the following clause:

"Permittee shall at all times by-pass a minimum of one-half (1/2) cubic foot per second at the point of diversion to maintain fish life."

Application 8768 was filed on August 20, 1936 by George R. Winslow in the name of Sacramento Pyramid No. 3 A. E. O. Scouts for power purposes. The point of diversion is located as described in the final paragraph of your communication. Permit 4886 was issued pursuant to the application on February 4, 1937.
