concerning accounts and financial transactions of the District, crops produced on lands within the District, and the irrigation water supply and the disposition thereof.

(b) Duly authorized representatives of each party shall have the right, during business hours, to inspect and make copies of the other party's books and official records insofar as they relate to matters covered by this contract.

#### CHANGES IN ORGANIZATION OF DISTRICT

24. While this contract is in effect, no change shall be made in the District by inclusion or exclusion of lands, by proceedings to dissolve, consolidate, merge, or otherwise, except upon the Contracting Officer's written consent thereto.

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS

25. There is reserved to the Secretary of the Interior the right, so far as the purport thereof may be consistent with the provisions of this contract, the laws of the United States and of the State of California, to make operating rules and regulations and to add to and modify them as may be deemed proper and necessary to carry out this contract, and to supply necessary details of its administration, and the District agrees to observe such rules and regulations.

#### CONTINGENT ON APPROPRIATIONS OR ALLOTMENTS OF FUNDS

26. The expenditure or loan of any money or the performance of any work by the United States hereunder which may require appropriations

1 (b) The District agrees to assign its annual payments of  
2 Ninety-seven Thousand Dollars (\$97,000) from the Utility District for  
3 the years 1974 through 2000 to the United States to be used to apply  
4 on the District's obligation under (b) of Article 10 of the Loan Contract.

5 3. A new article, Article 39, shall be added to the Loan Contract  
6 as follows:

7 WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

8 39. The District agrees that it will comply fully with all  
9 applicable Federal laws, orders, and regulations, and the laws of the  
10 State of California, all as administered by appropriate authorities,  
11 concerning the pollution of streams, reservoirs, groundwater, or water  
12 courses with respect to thermal pollution or the discharge of refuse,  
13 garbage, sewage effluent, industrial waste, oil, mine tailings, mineral  
14 salts, or other pollutants. The District further agrees that any contract  
15 it may enter into with other parties for the furnishing of Project water  
16 will contain a similar water pollution control article.

17 OFFICIALS NOT TO BENEFIT

18 4. (a) No Member of or Delegate to Congress or Resident Commissioner  
19 shall be admitted to any share or part of this contract or to any bene-  
20 fit that may arise herefrom, but this restriction shall not be construed  
21 to extend to this contract if made with a corporation or company for  
22 its general benefit.

23 (b) No official of the District shall receive any benefit that  
24 may arise by reason of this contract other than as a landowner within the  
25 District and in the same manner as other landowners within the District.
