RE: TAMARACK LAKE, ECHO AREA

Dear Harry:

In reviewing the records for fish planting in Tamarack Lake, I find the following plantings have been made:- During the period covered from 1936 to and including 1940, plantings of rainbow trout in amounts from 7,000 to 10,000 were made. Beginning 1941, eastern brook plants were made as follows:
