Gentlemen:

On November 29, 1954, the Board earmarked \$1,000 for aid to the Department of Fish and Game for the stream improvement projects planned by us on Taylor Creek and the Upper Truckee River at the south end of Lake Tahoe.

We indicated to the Board that we had \$3,000 budgeted for the outfall structure at the mouth of Taylor Creek and that it was possible that bids on the construction of this improvement might exceed the budgeted funds. The Board indicated its interest in this project and its willingness to supplement State funds on a cooperative basis to insure completion in the event bids should slightly exceed our budgeted funds.

Bids on this project have now been received and the low bid was for \$3,660 which was submitted by Mr. G. R. Amundson, Zephyr Cove, Nevada. In accordance with the request of the Board, we are enclosing a copy of the bid form, plans for the project, and a summary of the bids received. As you can see, this low bid exceeds our budgeted funds in the amount of \$660. Therefore, we would greatly appreciate the Board's consideration of allocating \$660 so that this project may be completed.

If this proposal meets with your approval, we would greatly appreciate it if a check in the appropriate amount would be issued, payable to the Department of Fish and Game, and transmitted to the attention of Mr. James Leiby, Accounting Section, Department of Fish and Game, 926 J Street, Sacramento, with an

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accompanying letter of transmittal indicating the purpose for which
the check is to be used.
