
Gentlemen:

Fallen Leaf Lake levels are still abnormally high for this date in spite of your field crew's excellent cooperation in letting us increase lake discharges.

Therefore, it will be necessary to fully open the dam outlet valve and to begin removing spillway flash boards no later than on the morning of Wednesday, November 27. We intend to remove a few boards at a time over the period from November 27 through December 2 to give the aquatic life somewhat of a gradual change in flows.

We will be grateful if you will inform all concerned Fish and Game personnel of this change so their Taylor Creek operations can be adapted accordingly.
