Subject: Taylor Creek

February 9, 1972, I talked to Elliot Graham, Lake District, El Dorado National Forest, concerning Taylor Creek.

1. Fish planting

A. Access roads - by next planting season (1972) two new roads will be "punched" into Taylor Creek.

(1) Near dam - west shore.

(2) Half way between dam and Highway 89, on east shore of river, off Cathedral road.

B. Water flows - with one year of flow regulation experience and public pressure, a longer fishing season will be possible in 1972.
