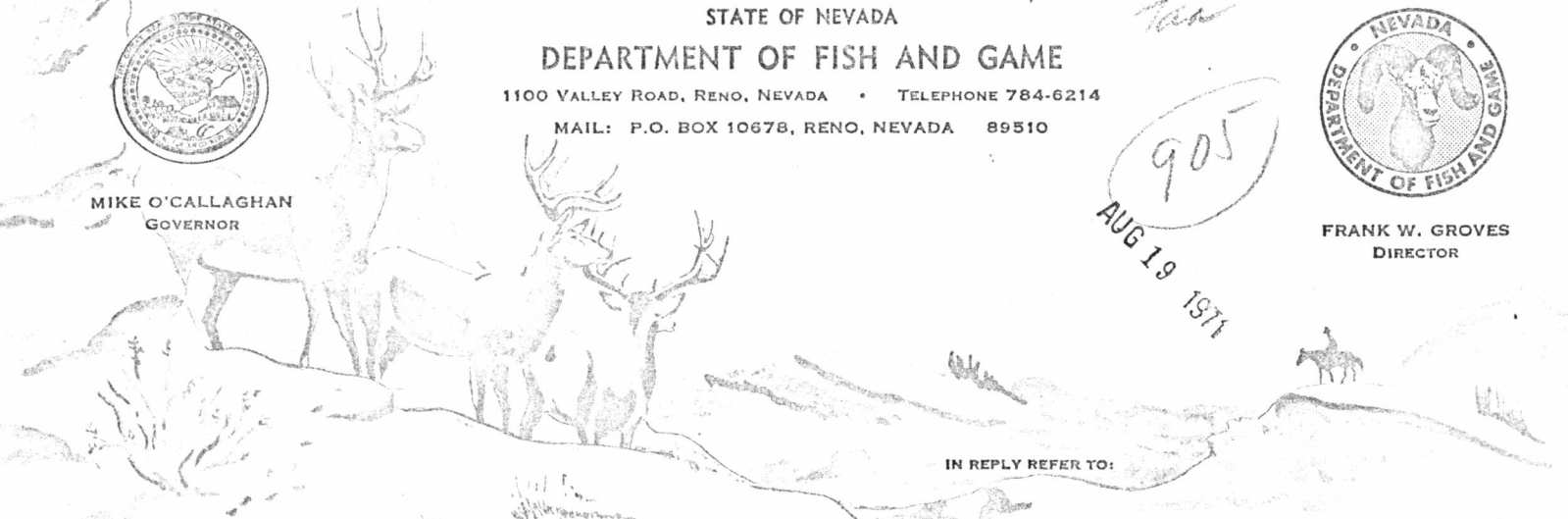

---to your letter of August 18 requesting kokanee eggs from Taylor Creek.

We would not object to you using Taylor Creek as a source of eggs. However, we would like to again caution you to take every precaution to prevent the further spread of this disease. While discussing the request with Tom Trelease, he assured me that progeny of these eggs would not be planted in Tahoe or waters that may lead to escapement or introduction of the disease in waters running into adjoining states. Would you please contact the USFS for clearance on the use of this land in regard to your request.
