SUBJECT: Examination of Taylor Creek for Spawning Trout - April 19, 1962

Walked out stream from Fallen Leaf Dam to several hundred feet below Highway 89 bridge. Water high and very clear. Flow estimated to be about 150 c.f.s. No sign of fish at fish ladder or below dam. One single trout about 18" long was observed laying in a tailwater of a large pool about 1/8 mile below dam. No attempts at redd making were noticed. Water temperature 45° F. at 1000 and 44° at 0840. Weather, cloudy with snow flurries and strong winds. Patches of snow 3-5 feet deep on banks.
