Challenges

- Eagle Conservation Plans became a recommended component of NEPA permitting by the BLM District/Field Offices.
- Mining companies were completing surveys and developing ECPs without clear guidance or need.
- Lack of communication and standardized/consistent permitting pathways for mining projects.



Opportunities

- Clear and consistent planning and permitting path.
- Improve coordination, communication, and efficiency for completing surveys, developing ECPs, and properly fulfilling NEPA requirements relative to BGPA.
- Mining companies collect raptor nesting data often in adjacent or overlapping buffers.



Accomplishments

- Discussed conservation measures and permitting needs
- Improved coordination
- Developed draft workflow
- Initiated a data-sharing process



Future Potential

- Review, comment, revise, and finalize workflow.
- Establish a data-sharing policy to help facilitate and control data.
