

FY 13/14 Proposal Solicitation Notice for Upland Game Bird Account Funding

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) is soliciting grant proposals from qualified non-profit organizations, local government agencies, colleges and universities, state departments, and federal agencies in the following subject areas:

If a proposal is funded, the grantee must submit additional information before a grant agreement is prepared and executed. The applicable forms described below are for informational purposes only. **Do not submit these forms with your proposal.** When applicants are notified that their project has been approved for funding, they shall be required to complete, sign, and return the forms if they are not already on file. These additional forms include:

- Certification of Nonfederal Contributions: In-kind/Third Party (GMB Form D.)

- Federal Taxpayer ID Number
