## 2006-2007 Wild Pig Take Report

## Summary:

The 2006-2007 wild pig hunting season ran from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 with no daily possession or seasonal bag limits. The License and Revenue Branch reported this year's fiscal sales to be 54,607 tags sold. This figure includes 44,387 individual resident tags, 1,105 non-resident tags and 9,115 lifetime tags. Successful hunters returned 4,570 (8%) wild pig report cards.

Over the past several years the central area has led state harvest totals. This year's harvest numbers increased 2% over last year's reported take of 57%. Monterey and Kern counties had the highest harvest figures not only within the central coast area, but also statewide. Although Monterey led harvest totals statewide at 19%, a decrease of 5% was observed in this county since last season. While Monterey County's take numbers reflected a decrease in harvest, hunters in Kern County reported a total take of 17%-an increase of 3% over last season.

The northern area and northern central area had the second highest harvest totals statewide for a combined take of 26%. Tehama and Lake Counties reported the highest take within these areas. In the northern area, Tehama County reported 6% while Lake County reported 5% of the total harvest within the northern central area. Harvest totals from Tehama County remain consistent, and Lake County harvest totals demonstrate an upward trend of 4% since the 2002-2003 season.

The bay delta area accounted for 9% of the statewide total. Sonoma County had the highest harvest at 5%-a decrease of 2% over last year's reported take of 7%. The take for Santa Clara County remained the same as last season at 4% of the total.

The breakdown of sex and areas hunted is as follows: 53% of the total take were males and 45% were females; last season, 93% of the pigs taken were harvested on private lands. This season the total harvest for private lands was 92%. The remaining pigs were taken on state and federal public lands such as wildlife areas, national forests, Bureau of Land Management facilities and military bases.

As reported in the past, the most successful method of hunting was with a rifle, representing 90% of the total harvest. Comparable to last year, 6% of pig hunters reported success using trailing hounds. Archery hunters reported 4%, and all other methods combined accounted for 5% of the total take.
