LICENSED FUR TRAPPERS REPORT 1977-78

A total of 1,889 trapping licenses were sold in the 1977-78 fur trapping season. This is an increase of 12% from the 1,692 licenses sold in 1976-77 and an increase of 103% from the 931 sold in the 1975-76 season.

Legislation enacted in 1974 requires every person who now takes furbearing or nongame mammals for profit to purchase a trapping license. The fees are \$10 - adult, \$5 - juvenile, and \$25 - nonresident.

Revenue received by trappers from the sale of furs in 1977-78 based on average prices paid by fur buyers at trapper's association fur sales was \$1,159,126.50. This is the highest fur revenue recorded and the first time the reported value has exceeded \$1,000,000. This record revenue also represents an increase of 36% from the \$855,314.00 reported for the 1976-77 season (Table 1). The average income for successful trappers in 1977-78 was \$1,142. This is an increase of 5% from the \$1,088 per trapper of 1976-77. However, this was not as high as the \$1,221.45 per trapper of 1975-76.

Each year a portion of the fur harvest is reported unsold. During 1977-78 season 6% was unsold, a slight increase from the 4 to 5% of recent seasons. For the purpose of this report unsold pelts have the same monetary value as marketed pelts. Therefore, the estimated value of the 1977-78 fur harvest was \$1,225,631.50, an increase of 37% from the \$895,603 for 1976-77.

Bobcats, for the third successive year, were the most economically important animals providing fur. Although 5,111 bobcat export tags were sold in the first year tags were required for out-of-state shipment of bobcat furs, holders of trapping licenses only reported the take of 4,445 bobcats.

The reported take of 4,445 is an increase of 23% over the reported take of 3,618 bobcats taken in 1976-77 and represents 5.8% of the 1977-78 catch. The average price paid for bobcat pelts was \$106, an increase of 39% from the \$76 paid during 1976-77. However, the average price was still below the \$113.50 paid in 1975-76. The increased number of bobcat pelts taken and the increase in fur value resulted in an increase of 69%, to \$446,790.00, in the total revenue provided by bobcat fur.

Muskrats accounted for 63% of the total harvest. The 48,562 is a reduction of 18% from the 1976-77 season and of 33% from the 1975-76 season. This probably reflects the two year statewide drought which ended during the 1977-78 season. The average price paid for muskrat pelts was \$4.67, an increase of 10% from the \$4.25 paid in 1976-77.

Other furbearers represented 30.8% of the total reported harvest (Table 2). Coyote, gray fox and raccoon continue to be the dominant minor furs although if present trends continue coyotes could replace muskrats as the second most valuable furbearer in California. The take of furs of all species increased except for badger (down 9%), weasel (down 57%) and muskrat.

Furs were reported taken in all counties except San Francisco County.
