

Harms Bros. Awarded Bid On Runway

Acceptance of Harms Brothers bid for construction of the runway extension at the Lake Tahoe Airport has been recommended to the federal aviation agency by the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors.

The Harms Brothers bid, one of two submitted, was for \$275,430. A Teichert and Sons bid the work for \$333,986.

Both bids were higher than the original engineering estimates which placed the price at about \$216,000. The bids were opened Thursday and were considered by the supervisors at last week's board meeting.

The supervisors also signed an agreement with Melzian and Spillman of South Tahoe for engineering services on the airport project.

The lease with Bridgeford Flying service, fixed base operator at the airport, was amended so Bridgeford will receive thirty per cent of all income derived from landing and takeoff fees for light aircraft. For charter and leased aircraft landings and takeoffs, the firm will get twenty per cent, the original figure set forth in the lease agreement. The change is retroactive to Aug. 1.
