cover the length of the fish. We formerly have had fish that exceeded that, but they were the steelhead-black spotted hybrids and they have ceased to appear at our racks. We might get fish over thirty inches, but I doubt it.

Duration of spawning seasons at U. T. Racks


Year	First spawning	Last spawning
1934	Mch. 27	May 26
1935	Apl. 15	June 4
1936	Apl. 14	May 29
1937	Apl. 17	May 22
1938	Apl. 25	May 30

In 1934 we had a large percentage of hybrids, which no doubt has a bearing upon the early date of the first spawning.

As you may see from the above, we no doubt will have fish on hand early in April when you arrive. The date of the last spawning nearly always is the date at which the racks are pulled and the station closed, but we will have fish on hand in advance of the date of the first spawning.
