Racks operated by William Die, April 13 to May 24.

Downstream fish lifted over racks:

Prior to May 2, about	40
May 2 - 9	40
May 10 - 16	18
May 17 - 24	<u>28</u>
Total	126

It is evident that the fish counted down were only a fraction of the run, since some undoubtedly died upstream, others came down over the racks at high water, and others had not yet come down when the racks were closed (all the downstream fish above were adult rainbows).

The only conclusion is that we missed the first part of the run (the run started very early in Taylor Creek, and was large).
