My dear Mr. Robertson:

Under date of August 18, 1954, the Clerk for the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors wrote a letter to Mr. B. E. Faist who is our Fish and Game Warden in Georgetown conveying the Board of Supervisors' request that the Department of Fish and Game make a survey of the Upper Truckee River with regard to the possibility of establishing fish rearing ponds in that area south of Highway 50.
