Dear Mr. Robertson:

Please excuse the delay in replying to your letter of September 20, which has been caused by an illness in the family requiring an absence on my part.

I am very much encouraged by your indication that you desire to embark on a project to improve the natural spawning areas in Lake Tahoe and its tributary streams. For quite some time we have had a plan for improving the Upper Truckee River. Any action on our part to carry out this plan has been delayed because of legal difficulties involved in spending State funds on privately owned land. We believe we have this problem resolved to a point where we can now proceed with at least initial development, but of course we may not be able to accomplish very much until next spring or summer because of weather conditions.

I would like to have the opportunity of going over this project with you, on the ground, at Lake Tahoe in the very near future. I believe that if Mr. Don Kelley, our Associate Fisheries Biologist, was to accompany me on a short field trip to the area with you, I am sure that it would be beneficial for all of us and perhaps we could arrange a cooperative program of mutual interest to the County of El Dorado and the Department.

I would like to suggest the dates of November 12 or 15 for this trip, weather permitting. If either of these dates are satisfactory to you, we can plan to meet you at Bijou or Tahoe Valley at any time or place you may desire to select.
