This is to formally notify you that this committee took the following action at its meeting September 12 in Tahoe Valley:

IT WAS MOVED BY SENATOR BROWN, SECONDED BY SENATOR TEALE, AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED THAT THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON FISH AND GAME REQUEST THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME AND THE STAFF OF THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD, IN COOPERATION WITH LOCAL SPORTSMEN AND OTHER INTERESTED GROUPS, TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE WHAT STEPS ARE NECESSARY TO PROVIDE FOR THE BETTERMENT OF SPAWNING AREAS AND FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF STREAMS TRIBUTARY TO LAKE TAHOE, AND THE COSTS INVOLVED; AND THAT SUCH INFORMATION BE REPORTED TO THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD AND TO THIS COMMITTEE AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE DATE.

It is hoped that the Department and the Board will be able to comply with the above request.
