Dear Mr. Burlingham:

Since I talked with you at the Senate Interim Committee meeting at Lake Tahoe we have given serious thought to the probable effects of your proposed development on the lower section of the Upper Truckee River.

Channelization of the lower section of this stream and elimination of the marshy area will have a marked detrimental effect on this important nursery area for small trout and other fishes. These areas provide extensive resting, hiding, and feeding grounds for large numbers of small fish. Your project will, therefore, be detrimental to the future of fish and fishing in both Lake Tahoe and the Upper Truckee River.
