SUBJECT: Erosion Control, Upper Truckee River, El Dorado County

This will reply to your memo of July 24, 1957, on the above subject. In looking over the attached agreement, it looks good to me, and I am wondering if there would be any advantage in putting in a renewal clause. In the event the first five years work may be successful, and you will want to continue the project, such a clause would leave the door open and might make it a little easier.

In addition to these two parcels, the Board of Supervisors of El Dorado County have purchased a parcel of land for an airport and have stated they would be perfectly willing to make all of the river portion available to the Department. If this is of interest, it might be well to check with the Chairman of the Board, and I think you will have no difficulty in working out a use agreement.

In looking over the minutes of the Wildlife Conservation Board meetings, I find that on June 3, 1949, August 25, 1949, and November 29, 1954, the Board made allocations for the Eldorado Flow Maintenance Dams, Project No. 1. In all of the motions enacted by the Board, the funds allocated were for the purpose of constructing dams on high mountain streams to permit maintaining water flow. Since the action of the Board was quite specific, it would probably be best to secure Board approval for the Upper Truckee work either by transferring funds from the flow maintenance dams project or by establishing a new project. I think the Department of Finance will raise some questions unless there is more specific authorization for the Upper Truckee work which is basically erosion control work.

If you have more funds in the original project No. 1 allocation than is required, then I would suggest requesting transfer.
