

EROSION CONTROL PROJECT ON UPPER TRUCKEE RIVER

We have reviewed the report on the proposed erosion control project on the Upper Truckee River which was prepared by Ray Nesbit for presentation to the Wildlife Conservation Board. We believe that this report adequately describes the problem and the corrective measures we wish to see undertaken.

Since the Upper Truckee River is one of the few remaining tributaries to Lake Tahoe where fish may spawn, we feel that it is highly important to institute erosion control measures on this stream as quickly as possible. We trust the Wildlife Conservation Board will act favorably on our proposal.
