SUBJECT: Plan for Study of Upper Truckee River


The work is piled so high on my desk that I will be unable to get a detailed plan for the Upper Truckee River work to you before your meeting next week. I am not sure this will make any difference.

As soon as possible, I will draft this plan, and we will send it to the Deputy Director with a request that the staff assist in determining whether or not the Upper Truckee River erosion control project does improve fishing in Lake Tahoe.

Ernie Murphey and I are coming up Monday, April 10, to look over sites for upstream and downstream traps, and the Region is meeting with El Dorado County planners and the Tahoe Area Council on April 11, at 10:00 a.m. at the Tahoe Area Council office to discuss some solutions to protecting erosion control work on the stream.

We had a meeting last Monday with Nesbit and Calhoun, and I am enclosing a copy of the notes I took for your information.
