SUBJECT: Rehabilitation, Upper Truckee River, El Dorado County

There has been determined that 6,000 rainbow trout catchables will adequately stock the sections of the Upper Truckee River damaged by the outflow from Echo Lake. Study and survey have indicated that the hatch of the natural spawned eggs from the rainbow and brown trout in this area has been very good. It would not be of any advantage to place additional fingerling stock from hatchery sources in these waters.

We hope that this will give you the information necessary to advise those who inquire of our program for the Upper Truckee River.
