Dear Mr. Hall:

On February 7, 1963, Mr. R. D. Beland of this office and Mr. Bob O'Mahoney of Tahoe Paradise Inc., had occasion to inspect the effect of the recent flood on your diversion works located on the Upper Truckee River adjacent to the Tahoe Paradise property. The river has cut a new channel through the east bank and the diversion works and fish ladder are now dewatered and partially destroyed.

Should you decide to repair the existing structure and divert the river back to its former channel or build a new diversion in the present channel, we would appreciate receiving notice prior to the formulation of your detail plans, so that we can advise you on the design of suitable fish facilities.
