Dear Mr. Brown:


In reply to your letter of March 4, 1969, we are enclosing our Purchase Order No. 1751, for 240 pounds of rainbow trout (2 to 5 per pound) at \$1.00 per pound.

The fish may be stocked in the Upper Truckee River at any time from June 15 to August 1, 1969, in the general area of the Highway 50 - Upper Truckee River bridge crossings above and below the golf course.

This permit is good only for duration of calendar year in which issued. It may be revoked for good cause at any time. A separate permit is required for each water to be stocked.

All fish planted under this permit must be free from infectious disease.

A copy of this permit must be carried at all times while transporting the above specified numbers and species of fish.

All fishing in private waters stocked under this permit must be done in accordance with State angling regulations, including angling licenses, seasons, and bag limits.
