Eric Gerstung is no longer with Environmental Services, therefore your memo of August 2, 1977 was referred to Region 2.

The Tahoe Paradise Resort Improvement District has applied for an extension of time to complete a diversion from the upper Truckee River under Permit 14675 (WA 19965). The project involves creation of a 44 acre-foot pond. The Department negotiated an agreement with the applicant and the terms of that agreement were included in Decision 1200 (copy attached). The District does not plan a hatchery but would raise or plant fish in the lake. This Department will control planting of fish through our planting permit requirement. We therefore would have control of disease problems.

The Department will not protest the extension of time because of our agreement but I assume others will object. Water is short in the Truckee drainage this year, and in fact most years.
