Subject: Upper Truckee River Project File

The treatment should be scheduled for the week of September 11. This will allow for advance fish salvage. A decision on the need or desirability of fish salvage has yet to be made. It may be a selling point to opponents.


The meeting with TRPA and Lahontan Water Quality Board is scheduled for 1000 on April 14 at TRPA offices. Purpose is to review concepts, needs, procedures, environmental concerns, etc. with regulatory agencies before going public.

Public meetings are scheduled in Placerville in El Dorado County Supervisors chambers, Bldg. A, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville from 1900 to 2200 on June 22.

The second public meeting will be at South Lake Tahoe city council chambers, 1052 Tata Lane from 1900 to 2200 on June 29.

Charles von Geldern has agreed that Region 2 will chair public meetings with support from IFD. A decision has not yet been made who will represent IFD. On this basis, O'Brien will run the meetings. I plan to run through a list of possible questions and answers with everything that could possibly come up. Methodology and the nuts and bolts of the treatment will be handled by Flint and Wickwire. These three presentations will allow free questioning from the audience. The project should be fully thought through before the April meeting.

An advance meeting to review it will be held at Wickwire's headquarters at 1000 on April 13. This will be Region 2 in-house only.
