

Subject: Middle Velma Lake, El Dorado County

This lake has an annual allotment of 6,000 RT and has been a good RT producer. One mono was set September 13, 1983 at the east end for 14 hours and caught 12 RT with the following lengths: 6.5, 7.0, 7.0, 7.0, 7.0, 7.0, 7.5, 7.5, 8.0, 8.0, 8.0, 15.0 inches. All of the fish were in prime condition. There was no evidence of roundworms or tapeworms that were evident in 1977. The present allotment should be continued.
