Dear John:

You asked me for information regarding our management program for Union Valley Reservoir. Region 2 has supplied this information which I am happy to forward to you.

In June, 1962, two plantings of rainbow trout fingerlings were made for a total of 299,456 fingerlings. In August, 1962, an additional 67,650 were planted. A larger part of these three plants should be of catchable size for this season. In January, 1963, 101,750 rainbow fingerlings were planted. Another 300,000 will be planted this July.

The first Kokanee salmon fingerlings were planted on February 26, 1963, when 151,200 were placed in the reservoir as an initial plant. These will be followed by annual plants of 150,000 for three years. The numbers may have to be reduced somewhat if our egg sources are not productive.

I hope this is the information you desired.
