Dear Ms. Brown:

The California Department of Fish and Game (DFG) has planted the following species in Union Valley Reservoir, with the year of the last stocking:

Golden Shiner	(<u>Notemigonus crysoleucas</u>)	unknown
Kokanee	(<u>Oncorhynchus nerka</u>)	1973
Smallmouth Black Bass	(<u>Micropterus dolomieu</u>)	1981
Brown Trout	(<u>Salmo trutta</u>)	1984
Brook Trout	(<u>Salvelinus fontinalis</u>)	1991
Lake Trout	(<u>Salvelinus namaykush</u>)	1992
Rainbow Trout	(<u>Oncorhynchus mykiss</u>)	1992

The DFG plans to plant 8,500 pounds of Rainbow Trout in 1993. The trout will be delivered by several trips during the period April - July. Also reported to be present in the reservoir are Sacramento Sucker (Catostomus occidentalis) and Green Sunfish (Lepomis cyanellus).

Information on life histories and behavior of the fishes of Union Valley Reservoir may be found in "Inland Fisheries Management", Alex Calhoun, 1966. I have a copy which you are welcome to see at our office in Rancho Cordova.
