

Subject: Notes on Fishing in Upper Velma Lake, El Dorado County, July 15 - 19

Three to five parties containing as many as 20 persons were camped on lake all week. Another 20 explorer scouts were camping on Lull Lake immediately downstream. Inflow about 3 cfs (many small trout). Surface of lake 67°F in afternoons. Eastern brook 3" - 7" extremely numerous and actively surface feeding in evenings. Dry fly action excellent. A few 10" - 13" EB were landed. Several rainbows to 9" were landed. RT comprised less than 10 percent of catch. EB population appears to be at saturation.
