ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Hunters must possess a valid 2014-2015 California hunting license and upland game bird stamp. Hunters possessing a junior hunting license do not need an upland game bird stamp and must be accompanied by a non-shooting adult 18 years of age or older. All shooters and non-shooters must wear shooting safety glasses, some blaze orange, and initial and sign the enclosed waiver.

Please come prepared and wear appropriate gear for the hunt; we strongly recommend you bring water, a hat, sturdy shoes/boots, sweater/jacket, mosquito repellent and a cooler with ice for your birds. For safety; Apprentice hunters must have a properly fitted shotgun. Please note if you are not prepared for the hunt or your gear is deemed unsafe you may be asked to withdraw from the hunt.

**** IF YOU ARE MORE THAN 30 MINUTES LATE FOR CHECK-IN, WITHOUT NOTIFICATION, YOUR SPOT MAY BE FILLED BY ANOTHER HUNTER.**

****IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS HUNT, YOU MUST NOTIFY **NICK BECHTEL** WITHIN 48 HOURS AT (562)254-8969. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY MAKE YOU INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN NEXT SEASON'S HUNTS.**

****NOTE: IF YOU OR ANY OF YOUR GUEST HUNTERS ARE IN NEED OF SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS DUE TO A DISABILITY, CONTACTING ME NO LESS THAN 7 DAYS IN ADVANCE OF THE HUNT DATE WILL BE NECESSARY.** Thank You

Each participant must provide the following:

-A valid California hunting license (with upland game bird stamp, unless junior license)
-A non-hunting adult who is legally responsible for a junior hunter. If your parent or guardian cannot walk with you and they have signed the waiver, a volunteer will accompany you.

**** Dog handlers are not considered an escort.**

-Appropriate hunting attire including thick jeans to ward off vegetation. A blaze orange hunting vest and safety glasses are required for all persons in the field. If you don't have these items they may be loaned to you.

-Low base shot shells, size 7 1/2, or smaller, i.e. no- #6, #5 or #4 size shot. **No Magnum** loads are allowed.

-Your own food and drinks and water for your dog.

-A good attitude and willingness to follow instructions.

***** YOU MUST SIGN ALL NECESSARY WAIVERS BEFORE YOU WILL BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE.**

***** YOU MUST PRINT ENOUGH NECESSARY WAIVERS FOR YOUR GROUP!!!**

You may bring your own hunting dog, but are required to obey hunter etiquette and maintain control of your dog. If your dog cannot remain in your control, you will be asked to leave your dog in your vehicle. This is not a training opportunity for dogs.

The Upland Game Bird Special Hunts Program is pleased to offer you this special hunt. Practice good sportsmanship, enjoy your hunt and most of all, be a safe hunter.

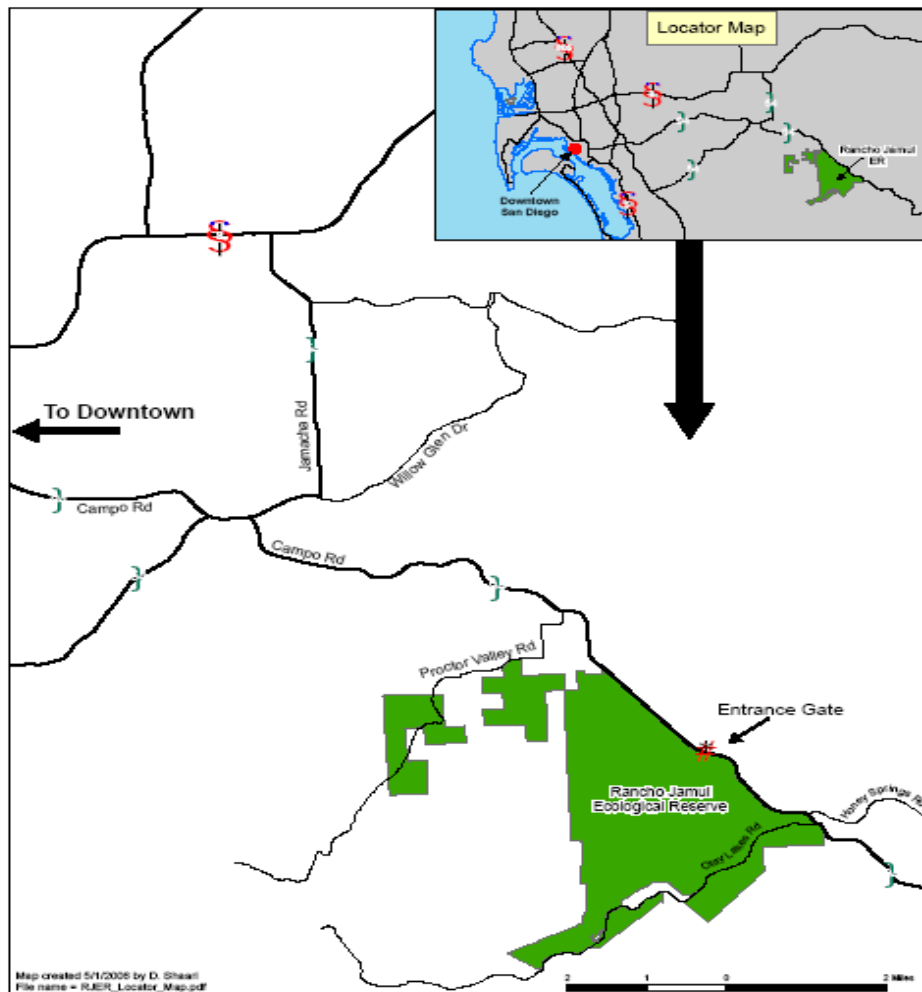

Directions to Rancho Jamul Ecological Reserve.

Take interstate freeways I-5, I-805, or I-15, then go east on interstate 8 to HWY-125 South to Highway 94 East (Campo Road). Travel through the cities of Spring Valley and Jamul. Rancho Jamul is approximately 2 miles past the San Diego Rural Fire Station on the right-hand side when traveling east.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING SPECIAL HUNTS AND JUNIOR HUNTERS

*Please arrive for check-in on time.

Each participant must provide the following:

- An adult that is legally responsible for the participating Junior Hunter.
- A valid hunting license (adults need an upland game bird stamp).

- **All participating hunters, escorts and Dog Handlers are required to wear shooting safety glasses with an ANSI rating of Z87.1 while in the field. There are glasses to borrow if you do not have your own.**

- Appropriate hunting attire including thick jeans to ward off the vegetation.

- The hunt will be held rain or shine, so please be prepared.
- Bring low-base shot shells, size 7 ½ or 8 **No magnum loads** are allowed. Junior hunters may have **only up to two** shots in the magazine or chamber while hunting.

- Bring your own food and drinks, and water for your dog.

- A good attitude and willingness to participate and follow instructions.

ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH until you are out in your respective hunting areas. If your dog will not perform well around other dogs then it is best to leave the dog at home. Please leave your dog and your firearm in your vehicle until after the pre-hunt orientation is over and you are out in the field. READ, INITIAL AND SIGN BEFORE HUNT DAY

Waiver of Potential Claims and Release of Liability

I, _____, as a condition of my being able to participate in hunting activities on State property acknowledge and represent to the State of California each of the following:

1. Hunting is an inherently dangerous activity that can result in serious injuries or death caused by myself or other people who are present, participating in or watching such activities. _____

2. Hunting also includes an inherent risk of serious injury or death caused by conditions of the land, including both defects in or improvements thereto, or natural conditions including animals (whether those being hunted or not) on the property. The State has not made any representations that the conditions of the property are suitable for hunting or that the property is free from defects. _____

3. I acknowledge that in allowing me to participate in hunting activities on State property, the State owes me no duty to supervise the activity or the persons participating in or watching the activity. I further acknowledge that by providing rules, signs, guides, chaperones or other volunteers to assist in hunting activities, neither the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers owe me any duty whatsoever to supervise or control the actions of myself or other persons participating in, watching the activity or on the property. _____

4. Waiver And Release Of Claims: I hereby expressly waive any right that I might have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for any physical or emotional injuries, illnesses, death or other damages that I might suffer as a result of participating in hunting activities on State property. _____

5. Waiver And Release Of Claims Based On Negligence: In addition to the inherent dangers involved in hunting on State property described above, I further acknowledge that serious injuries or death may be caused by the negligent acts of State employees, its agents, volunteers or other persons which increase the risk of injury beyond those normally anticipated while hunting. I hereby expressly agree to assume the risk that I may be seriously injured or killed through the negligent acts of others. I agree to waive any right I may have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for injuries or death that I may suffer arising out of participating in hunting or related activities including physical or emotional injuries, illnesses or death caused by the negligent acts of the State, its agents, employees, volunteers or other persons. _____

Prior to executing this waiver and release of liability, I was given the opportunity to thoroughly read the entire document and to consult my own legal counsel regarding the potential effect of signing this agreement. I hereby consent to be bound by its terms and conditions.

READ, INITIAL AND SIGN BEFORE HUNT DAY

Waiver of Minor's Potential Claims and Release of Liability

I, _____, am the legal parent/guardian of _____, a minor under the age of 18 years (the "Child"), as a condition of the Child being able to participate in hunting activities on State property, I hereby acknowledge and represent to the State of California each of the following:

1. Hunting is an inherently dangerous activity that can result in serious injuries or death caused by myself, the Child or other people who are present, participating in or watching such activities. _____ Initial

2. Hunting also includes an inherent risk of serious injury or death caused by conditions of the land, including both defects in or improvements thereto, or natural conditions including animals (whether those being hunted or not) on the property. The State has not made any representations that the conditions of the property are suitable for hunting or that the property is free from defects. _____ Initial

3. I acknowledge that in allowing the Child to participate in hunting activities on State property, the State owes the Child no duty to supervise the activity or the persons participating in or watching the activity. I further acknowledge that by providing rules, signs, guides, chaperones or other volunteers to assist in hunting activities, neither the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers owe the Child any duty to supervise or control the actions of the Child or other persons participating in, watching the activity or on the property. _____ Initial

4. Waiver And Release Of Claims: I hereby expressly waive any right that the Child might have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for any physical or emotional injuries, illnesses, death or other damages that the Child might suffer as a result of participating in hunting activities on State property. _____ Initial

5. Waiver And Release Of Claims Based On Negligence: In addition to the inherent dangers involved in hunting on State property described above, I further acknowledge that serious injuries or death may be caused by the negligent acts of State employees, its agents, volunteers or other persons which increase the risk of injury beyond those normally anticipated while hunting. I hereby expressly agree that the Child assumes the risk that the Child may be seriously injured or killed through the negligent acts of others. I agree to waive any right the Child may have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for injuries or death that the Child may suffer arising out of participating in hunting or related activities including physical or emotional injuries, illnesses or death caused by the negligent acts of the State, its agents, employees, volunteers or other persons. _____ Initial

Prior to executing this waiver and release of liability, I was given the opportunity to thoroughly read the entire document and to consult my own legal counsel regarding the potential effect of signing this agreement. I hereby consent to be bound by its terms and conditions and consent to the Child being bound by its terms and conditions.

The Ten Commandments of Firearms Safety:

1. Watch that muzzle! Keep it pointed in a safe direction at all times.
2. Treat every firearm with the respect due a loaded gun.
3. Be sure of your target and what is in front of it and beyond it.
4. Keep your finger outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot .
5. Check your barrel and ammunition.
6. Unload firearms when not in use.
7. Point your firearm only at something you intend to shoot.
8. Don't run, jump, or climb with a loaded firearm.
9. Store firearms and ammunition separately and safely.
10. Don't drink alcohol, use drugs or take medications that might impair your abilities and good judgment before or while handling firearms or archery equipment.
