- c -common-- Usually found in suitable habitat
- u -uncommon-- Present, but more often missed than seen
- r -rare-- Not seen every year, or only seen a few times during the year

**Other Codes:**

- \* -Local nester
- \*\* -Threatened or Endangered species
- ~ -Sub- species
