

Tejon Ranch, Kern County SHARE Pig Hunt Dates 2014/2015

Tejon Ranch is located 100 miles north of Los Angeles and 25 miles southeast of Bakersfield. Hunters will have access to approximately 100,000 acres of beautiful rugged mountains, steep canyons, oak covered rolling hills, and broad valleys.

- Tejon Ranch's semi-guided pig hunt is a two-night, two and a half day group hunt over three days
- 6 permits will be issued per hunt period
- Hunters check in at 1:30pm on Monday and the hunt ends at 10:00am on Wednesday
- Hunt **includes** lodging, meals, and a guide to direct hunters on techniques and areas to have a successful hunt, but generally not to accompany hunters in the field
- Successful applicants can bring **1 hunting partner**, Non-hunters are not allowed during this hunt
- Hunters will be driving their own vehicles on this hunt, **we strongly recommend a 4x4**, equipped to handle varying terrain and unimproved roads
- Hunters are limited to one pig tag each during this hunt
- Only **non-lead ammunition** will be allowed
- Successful applicants will be required to purchase hunter insurance (\$18.00) before the hunt. Information will be provided once drawn.
- Deadlines to submit applications (in parenthesis) are 17 days prior to hunt date

Period 1 – December 15-17 (***Due to the Thanksgiving holiday we will call successful applicants on Monday December 1st***)

Period 2 - January 26-28 (***Jan 9***)

Period 3 - February 23-25 (***Feb 6***)
