

CWHR Level II Modeling for 31 species (2002)

Each model is a Level II, spatially explicit wildlife habitat relationships model which builds on CWHR habitat suitability information with distance to resources, home range, habitat patch size, edges and territory. (Developed by US Forest Service Pacific Southwest Research Station for CDFG CWHR Program, 2002)
