- Birds treated at the International Bird Rescue (IBR) 323 total  
195 birds cleaned  
154 birds in pools  
24 birds released to date
  
- Species treated at IBR  
Surf Scoter 68%  
Horned Grebe 11%  
Greater Scaup 10%  
Bufflehead 6%  
shorebirds 3%  
other 2%
  
- Collected dead birds 170 total  
Species breakdown:  
Surf Scoter 49%  
Bufflehead 29%  
Horned Grebe 5%  
Greater Scaup 4%  
shorebirds 2%  
other 12%

**Total birds collected: 493**
