To reconsider the allocation for a grant to Western Rivers Conservancy for a cooperative project with the State Coastal Conservancy, the Wyss Foundation, and the Yurok Tribe, to acquire approximately 6,749 acres of mixed conifer forest property known as Blue Creek Phase 2B, in light of new information and changes proposed to the project after it was presented to the Wildlife Conservation Board on November 20, 2014. The proposed acquisition would protect riparian corridors, salmonid streams, coastal watershed and habitat linkages.

In compliance with Government Code Section 11123 (b)(1)(C), members of the public will have an opportunity to directly address the Wildlife Conservation Board on this Agenda item during its discussion or consideration of this item, at each teleconference location.

All votes shall be by roll call. The Board shall publicly report any action taken and the vote or abstention on that action of each member present for the action.
