The Inland Empire Economic Databank and Forecasting Center exists to provide a resource and source of expertise on the local economy for the citizens, companies, and municipal organizations of the Inland empire region.

We maintain a database compiling all economic data on the region released by the federal, state, and local governments. We are also working to expand the database to include data generated by private-sector organizations, including on-line, real-time data.

We utilize these data along with our economic expertise and experience to analyze and forecast the Riverside-San Bernardino economy. Inevitably, such analysis involves comparison of Inland empire economic trends to those for the rest of California and the U.S., and so our databank also includes data for other metro regions, for the state, and for the nation as a whole.

Our analyses are regularly presented in our monthly Inland Empire Review, in our annual year-end Economic forecast Breakfast, and in quarterly forecast updates presented to our sponsors. We also provide more specialized and periodic analyses of cities and regions within the Inland Empire within this Website.

We are also available to apply this expertise to topical research projects. In the past five years, we have performed major research projects on such topics as a) projected population growth in Riverside County cities, b) a list of the most compatible companies for recruitment into the Riverside County economy, c) the

prospective economic benefits of a rehabilitation of the Salton Sea, and d) the feasibility of air cargo operations out of the March Inland Port.

Our Center has been in existence since 1993. We look forward to being of service to you and your organization.
