Please allow 20 business days for processing application. Incomplete applications will be returned and could delay the issuance of your license. Contact the California Department of Fish and Wildlife's (CDFW), License and Revenue Branch at (916) 928-5846 or <u>SPU@wildlife.ca.go</u>v if you need additional information regarding commercial hunting club licenses.

- (917) A property is a number of contiguous (sharing an edge or boundary) legal parcels held by an owner or a combination of owners and held out for a common purpose. If you have more than one property, you must also complete a Commercial Hunting Club License Application Attachment and pay the appropriate license fee based on the number of properties used. This attachment is also available online at wildlife.ca.gov/Licensing/Commercial-Hunting-Club.
- (918) It is mandatory to complete all items unless specified as voluntary.
- (919) Sign and date the application.
- (920) Mail this application and attachment, which is required if you have more than one property, a copy of your business identification, and a cashier's check, money order, personal check or credit card authorization payment form to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, PO Box 944209, Sacramento, CA 94244-2090.

NOTICE

Disclosure Statement - Fish and Game Code (FGC) Sections 3240.5-3246, the CDFW is authorized to collect information from applicants to maintain a record of licensure. All information requested on this application is mandatory unless otherwise indicated. An applicant's name and city of residence may be provided to the public if requested. FGC Section 391, other personal information submitted on this application may be released for law enforcement purposes, pursuant to court order, or for official natural resources management purposes.

A licensee may obtain a copy of his/her license records maintained by the CDFW by submitting a written request to the Custodian of Records, California Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, PO Box 944209, Sacramento, CA 94244-2090 or LRB@wildlife.ca.gov. All requests must include the requestor's name, address, and telephone number.

BUSINESS IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 700.4(c), states any applicant applying for any license, tag, permit, reservation, or other entitlement issued via ALDS shall provide valid identification. All business applicants must provide documentation identifying the business' structure type. Acceptable forms of business identification include:

- Articles of Incorporation
- Articles of Organization

- Certificate of Limited Partnership
- Statement of Partnership Authority

If a business identification names individual(s), in the business' identification, each individual must provide a valid individual identification as described below and provide their date of birth, sex, hair and eye color, height and weight. Acceptable forms of individual identification include:

- Any license document or Get Outdoors identification number (GO ID) previously issued via ALDS
- A valid driver's license or identification card issued to him or her by the Department of Motor Vehicles or by the entity issuing driver's licenses from the licensee's state of domicile
- US Military Identification Cards (Active or reserve duty, dependent, retired member, discharged from service, medical/religious personnel)

- US Certificate or Report of Birth Abroad
- US Birth Certificate
- Tribal Identification Card, as defined by each sovereign tribal nation
- US Passport
- A foreign government-issued photo identification
- Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship
- Birth Certificate or passport issued from a US

Any applicant less than 18 years of age applying for any license, tag, permit, reservation, or other entitlement issued via the ALDS shall provide valid identification. Acceptable forms of identification include any form of identification described above; or a parent or legal guardian's identification as described above.

PAYMENT POLICY

Personal Checks will be accepted by the CDFW if name and address are imprinted on the check. Personal checks returned to the CDFW due to insufficient funds will render your license invalid. The CDFW may also deny the issuance or renewal of a license if a person has failed to reimburse the CDFW for the amount due. Any activity performed without a valid license is a violation of the FGC and therefore subject to enforcement action.

Credit Cards - Licenses, permits, tags, stamps, or registrations may be purchased with a Visa or MasterCard. **Cash is not accepted at CDFW's sales offices.**
